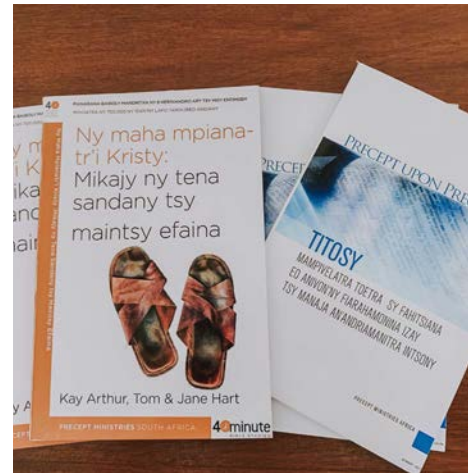

How do you forgive someone who caused your son's death?

This lady on her knees below has been attending a ladies group that has been working through our 40-Minute Study on forgiveness. At the end of the 2nd week she shared how she had been grieving for her son, who had been hit by a car and killed. Her heart was bitter towards the driver who had disappeared. This study not only led her to **forgive the driver who killed her son, but it also filled her heart with compassion to pray specifically for him/her.**
